Confession of Sin (Unison)

Eternal God, whose covenant with us is never broken, we confess that we fail to always fulfill Your will. Though You have bound Yourself to us, we will not fully bind ourselves to You. In Jesus Christ You serve us freely, but often we refuse Your love and withhold ourselves from others. We struggle to love You fully and to love one another as You command. Assurance of Pardon

Leader: The Lord is compassionate and gracious, slow to anger, abounding in steadfast love.

People: As far as the east is from the west, so far has God removed our transgressions from us.

All: Praise be to God! In Jesus Christ we are forgiven.

Leader: Since God has forgiven us in Christ, let us forgive one another. The peace of the Lord Jesus Christ be with you.

People: Peace be with you. (*Please move about the sanctuary passing the peace to one another.*)
